ALPHA OMEGA FEEDS 70 FAMILIES FOR THANKSGIVING

BALTIMORE, MD – Each Thanksgiving Alpha Omega sponsors a Basket Drive to provide Thanksgiving dinners to the community. This year's drive was by far one of the most successful. Organized by the Community Service Committee and chaired by Brother Michael Paylor, the chapter had a goal of helping 63 families, which was surpassed when 70 baskets were delivered.



The chapter received donations for basket components from brothers, sweethearts, other organizations, and individuals. On the Monday before Thanksgiving, brothers meet at Founder's Hall located at 1600 N. Calvert Street, Baltimore, MD 21202 to assemble the baskets.

Each basket contains everything needed to prepare a meal including a turkey, stuffing, cranberry sauce, gravy, string beans, greens, sauerkraut, macaroni and cheese, canned yams, instant potatoes, can of fruit, beverage, brown and serve rolls, mayonnaise, bread, and margarine. The baskets were then hand delivered to all the families the following evening.

The event was also successful because of the aid of outside organizations. They included the Alpha Delta Chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha, the Alpha Alpha Sigma chapter Sigma Gamma Rho, the Zeta Omega Sigma Chapter of Sigma Gamma, and the Maryland Alumnae Chapter of Pershing Angles.
